



Professor Robert Sutton will present a lecture entitled "Scaling Up Excellence," based on his best selling book. He will discuss how to spread, enhance, and amplify excellence at all levels of business and organizational management.

As the co-founder of the Stanford Technology Ventures Program and the Hasso Plattner Institute of Design, Sutton specializes in organizational change, leadership, innovation and workplace dynamics. He earned his Ph.D. in organizational psychology from The University of Michigan and has been a Stanford faculty member since 1983.

Sutton has co-written seven books, including national bestsellers "Good Boss, Bad Boss" and "Scaling Up Excellence." Sutton's work now focuses on the causes, drawbacks, and virtues of organizational friction.
